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Types of Staging

- Clinical staging
- Pathological staging

- Based on 7th Edition of AJCC staging
- 8th edition takes effect next year

Clinical Staging

- Microstaging of tumour
- Clinical & Radiological evaluation for metastasis
- After complete excision of the Primary

Pathological Staging

- Microstaging of primary <u>AND</u>......
- Regional lymph node evaluation

TNM

- Tumour depth size (T1 T4 a&b)
- Regional Lymph nodes (N1 N3 a,b,c)
- Metastasis (M1a,b,c)
- (LDH)

This forms the basis of the classification
